Angels In Need

Angels in need program requirements & guidelines.

- Maximum combined income of all working members of the household must be under (including deceased child):
2 member family: 2,344 monthly gross income / 3 member family: 2,948 monthly gross income / 4 member family: 3,553 monthly gross income / 5 member family: 4,157 monthly gross income / 6 member family 4,761 monthly gross income
- Applicant may be on public assistance, however any cash aid will be considered income.
- A maximum of \$5,000 (subject to change at anytime) will be contributed per infant.
- Funds can be used for: a) Funeral costs b) Burial Costs c) Cremation costs d) Cemetery plots e) Monuments f) Urns g) Flowers * a maximum of \$100 may be used towards flowers.
- Applicant must contribute at least 10% of funeral & headstone costs.
- Applicant may contribute more than 10% of costs.
- The final cause of death must be determined natural.
- Applicant must participate** in a minimum of 2 social events sponsored by The Great Battle Against SIDS within 1 year.
- NO applicant will receive any money from The Great Battle Against SIDS. The program will pay those providing services directly.
